“Czech Deputy Interior Minister to Keynote at the ASIS European Security Conference”

Brussels, 18 January 2011 –Mr Michal Moroz, Deputy Minister of the Interior of the Czech Republic, will be a keynote speaker at the 10th ASIS International European Security Conference & Exhibition that will be held in Vienna, Austria on 3-6 April 2011.
